

**Resolution No. 090618.1 to Adopt Property Tax Rate
Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 3**

BE IT CONSIDERED by the Board of Commissioners (the Board) of Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 3, that:

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized by Chapter 775 of the Health and Safety Code to collect ad valorem taxes within the district and is also required to annually set a tax rate;

WHEREAS, the Board caused to be published in a local newspaper a notice listing that year's tax rate and this year's proposed tax rate;

WHEREAS, on August 2nd, 2018 at a public meeting, the Board discussed and proposed a rate of \$0.096374 per \$100 for 2018/2019;

The Board was required to schedule two public hearings on this issue; and
WHEREAS, on August 16th, 2018 as well as August 23rd, 2018 notice was posted that the Board would meet on August 23rd, 2018 and August 30th, 2018 to hold public hearings on the proposed tax rate; and


WHEREAS, on August 30th, 2018 notice was posted that the Board would meet on September 6th, 2018 to adopt a tax rate. Now, therefore:


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY ESD No. 3 BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS THAT:

1. After due consideration, the Board of Commissioners adopted a tax rate of \$0.096374 per \$100 of the taxable property within the district. Of this amount, \$0.068475 is the maintenance and operations rate and \$0.027899 is the debt tax rate.
2. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 8 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$5.07.
3. This resolution will be filed by the Secretary of the Board and a copy provided to the Williamson County Tax Assessor-Collector.
