III. PRESENTATIONS

- 1. Fire Chief Report regarding facilities, apparatus and equipment, emergency operations, training, management activities, personnel matters, property tax, sales tax, intergovernmental relations, including written report. We have received our first COVID reimbursement check from Williamson County. Ladder 1 is in now service.
