### III. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

1. Discussion and possible action regarding budget for fiscal year October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 to September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Commissioner Guthrie made a motion with a second by Commissioner Cano to approve the 2021/2022 fiscal year budget as presented. Passed 4-0.
2. Discussion and possible action on District's 2021/2022 tax rate, including;
  - a) Take a record vote on the District's 2021/2022 tax rate and adopt an Order Levying Taxes;  
Commissioner Cano motioned that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100, which is effectively a 16.970% increase in the tax rate and adopt an Order Levying Taxes. Motion seconded by Commissioner Hejl. Record vote taken as follows:  
Commissioner Cano – yes; Commissioner Hejl – yes; Commissioner Guthrie – yes; Commissioner Brown – yes. Passed 4-0.
  - b) Authorize filing the Order with Williamson County Tax Assessor/Collector;  
Commissioner Cano made a motion with a second by Commissioner Hejl to authorize the filing of the Order with Williamson County Tax Assessor/Collector. Passed 4-0.
  - c) Acknowledge and approve posting of statement regarding adopted tax rate to home page of District website.  
Commissioner Guthrie made a motion with a second by Commissioner Cano to acknowledge and approve posting of statement regarding adopted tax rate to the home page of the district website. Passed 4-0.
